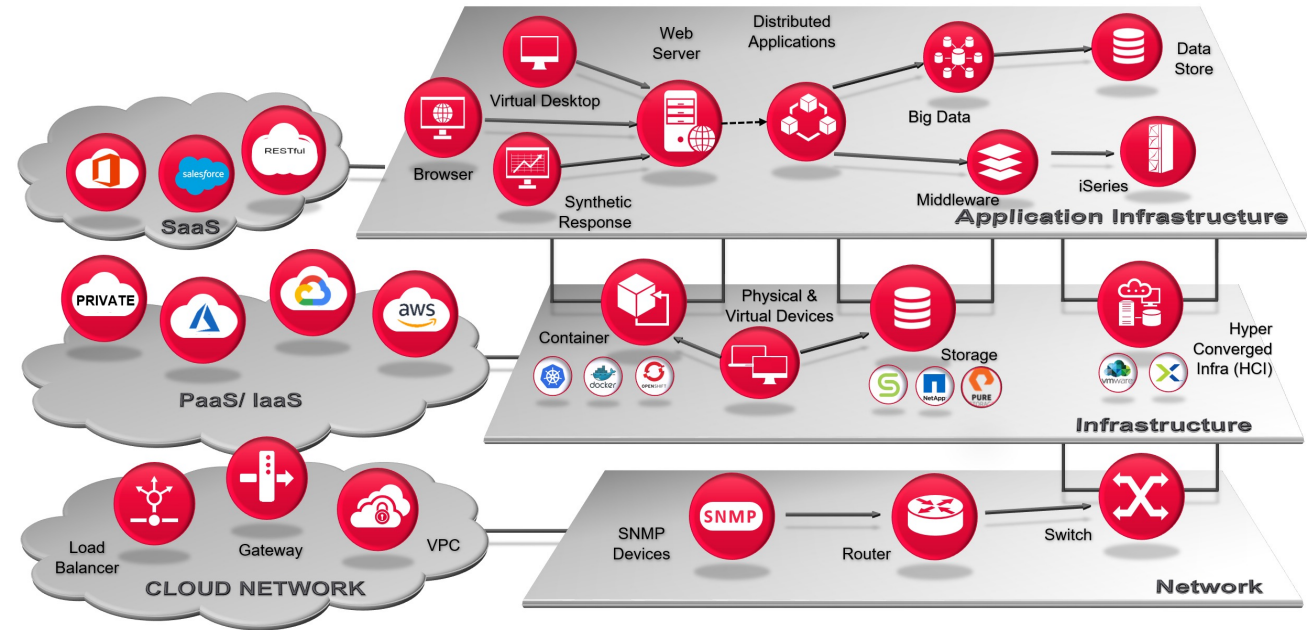

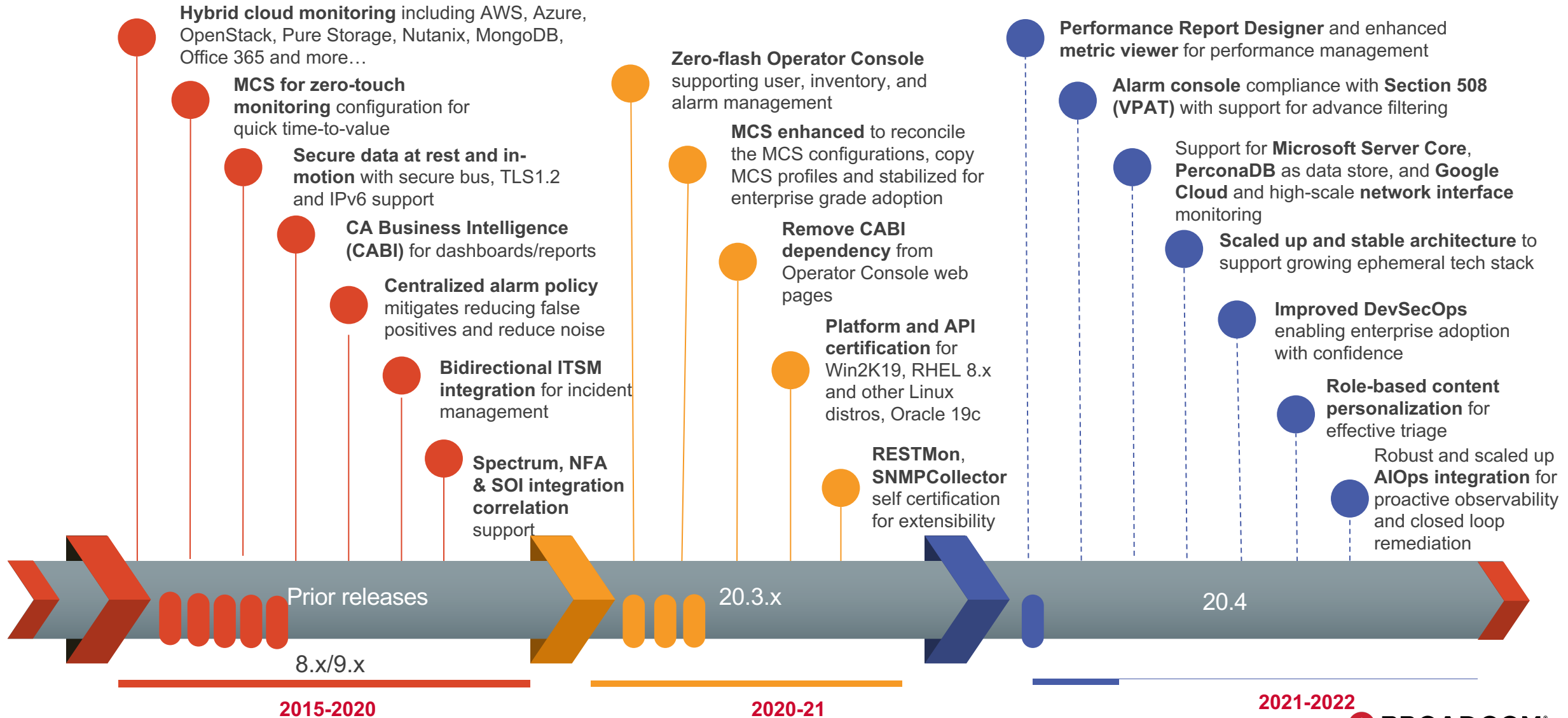

What's New with DX UIM 20.4



DX UIM 20.4 New Features for Improved Observability

Alarm Console

- Advance alarm filter with “and” and “or” conditions
- Collapsible alarm summary view
- ACL permission for alarm filters
- Global alarm filters on alarm console

User View Customizations

- Bridge LifeRay parity
- Set default Operator Console screen for user
- Operator Console views provide more granular control to users based on ACL permissions

Dashboards & Reports

- Seamless dashboard navigation from Operator Console
- Dashboard list widget as replacement for list reports
- Custom timeframe filtering across all reports and default screens

Inventory & Group Mgt

- Export DX UIM groups/devices along attributes including (MCS profiles and alarm policies)
- Increased number of device selection in (static) group configuration
- Additional attributes and customizable table columns

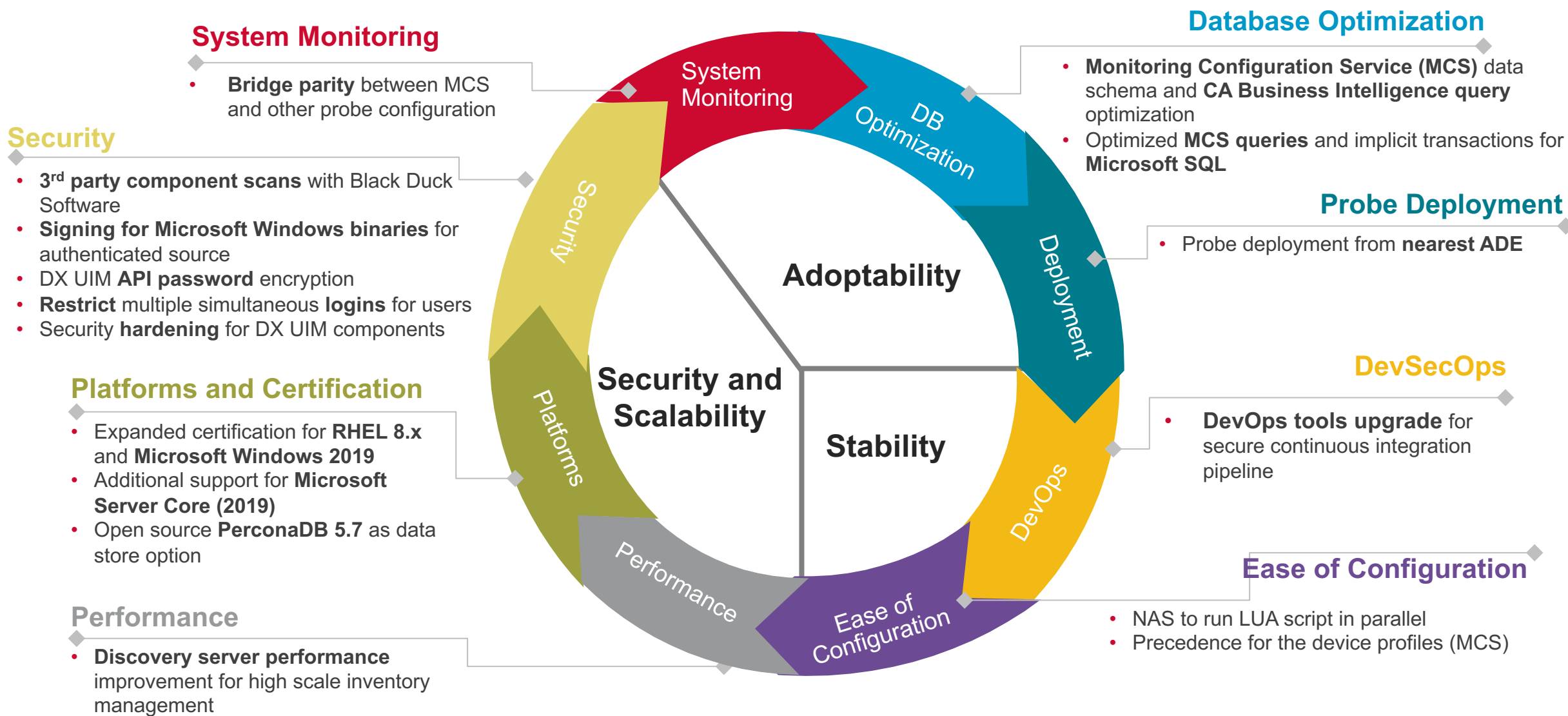
Performance Metrics

- Performance Report Designer (re-introduced)
- Enhanced Metric Viewer to support metric graphs with high scale targets (At A Glance)
- Metric Viewer: custom aggregate, copy metric views with enhanced device count

- Upgrade Operator Console to React version 17.0.x

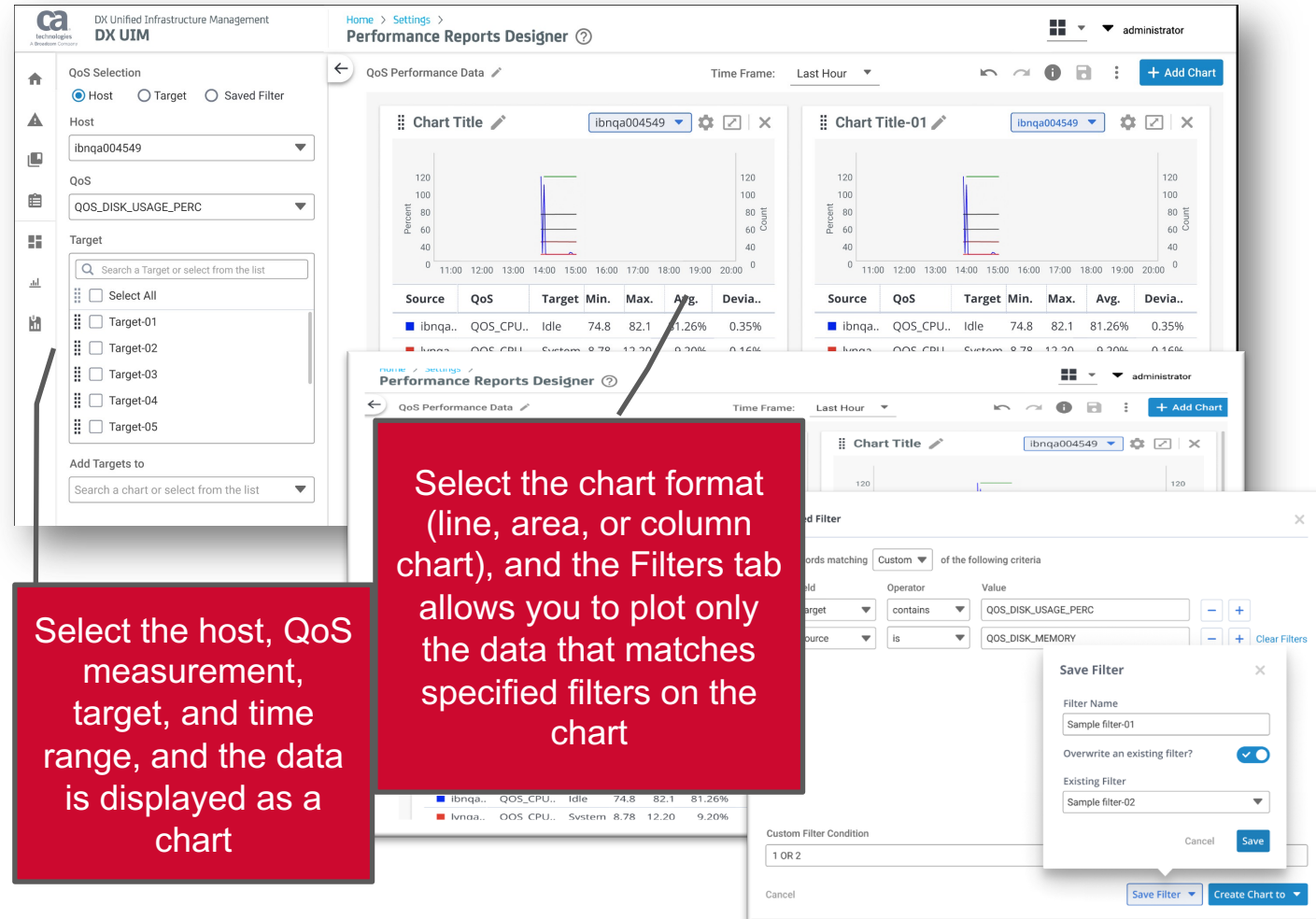

Performance Report Designer

Visual Representation of Quality of Service (Performance) Data

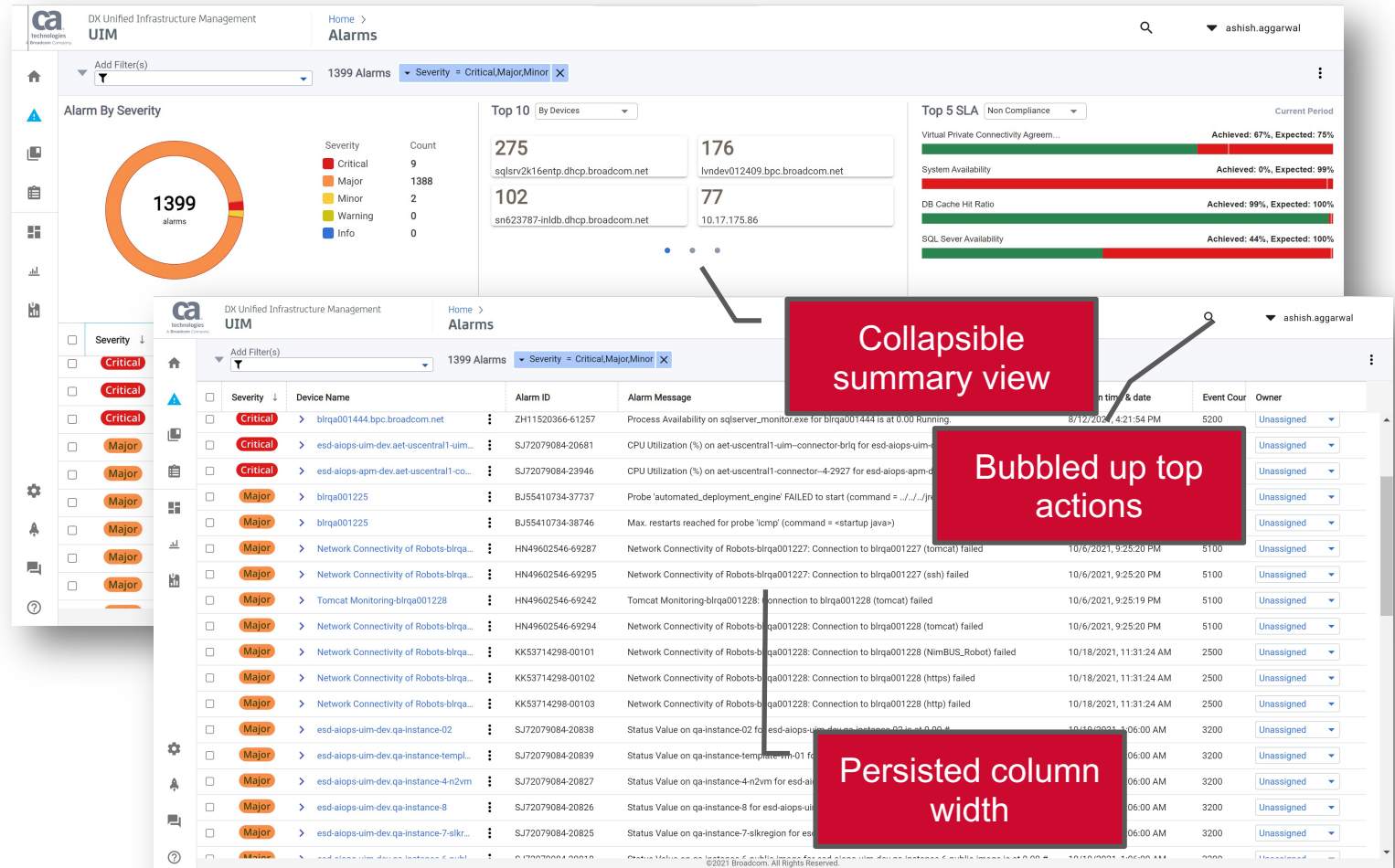
- ✓ **Quicker full stack triage** consistently across device(s)
- ✓ Display **multiple measurements** on a single chart, view multiple charts at a time
- ✓ **Drag charts** between rows or can drag a data series from one chart to another
- ✓ **Change the source** (host or target) of the data
- ✓ **Save** a set of charts as a report to print or to view later
- ✓ **Export and import** features to share charts with other users or across releases
- ✓ **Scheduled sharing** for performance (QoS) reports

UX Hygiene and Accessibility Improvements

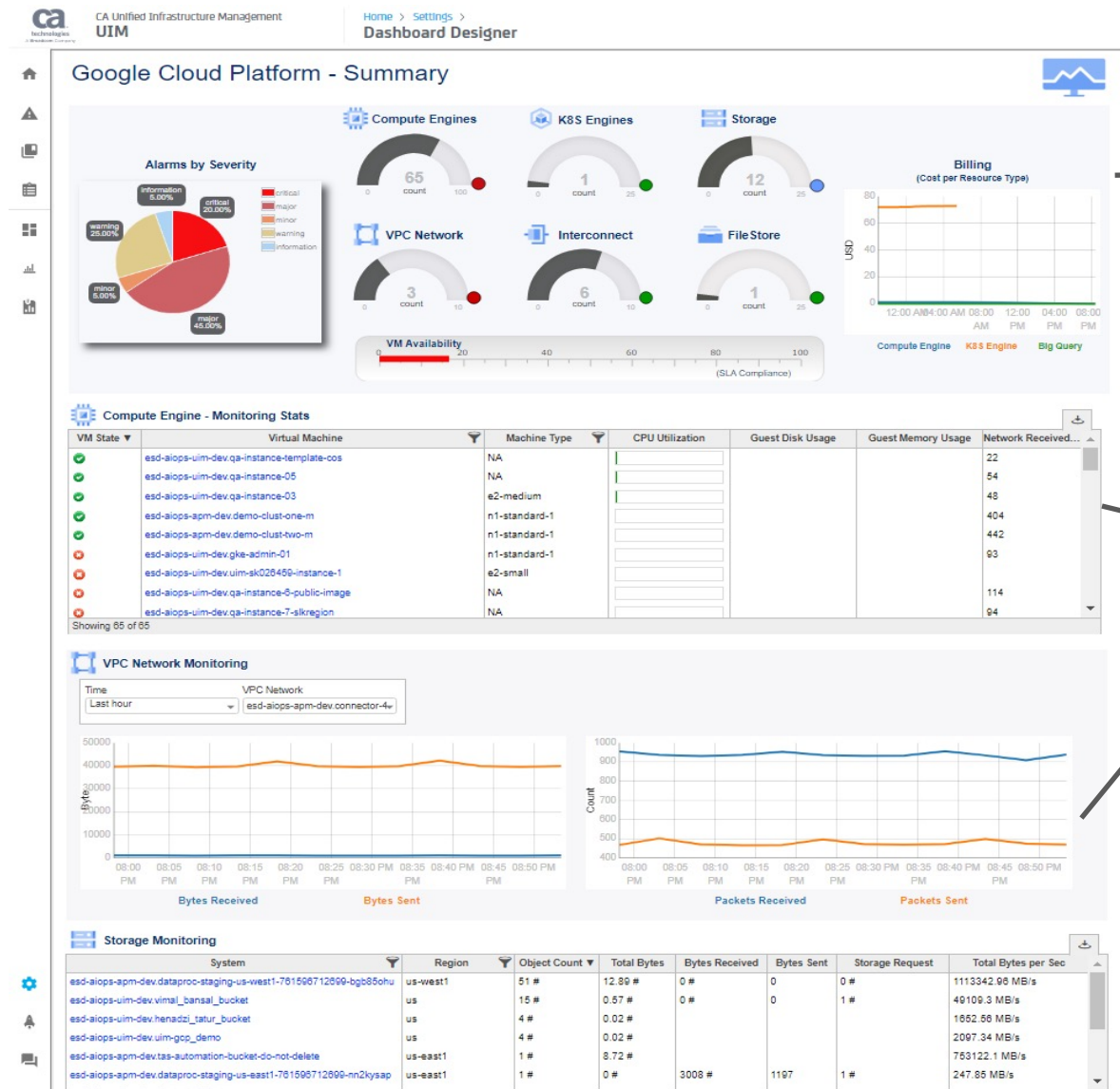
- ✓ Reduce fragmentation and better white space management

Understanding Monitoring Details

- ✓ View **additional** inventory attributes
- ✓ Inventory and group **summary view** customizations
 - Sortable columns
 - Editable table columns
- ✓ **Export** of inventory and group details for CMDB comparison
 - Device and attributes
 - Monitoring configuration details like MCS profiles and alarm policies

- ✓ **Customize** default home page on Operator Console

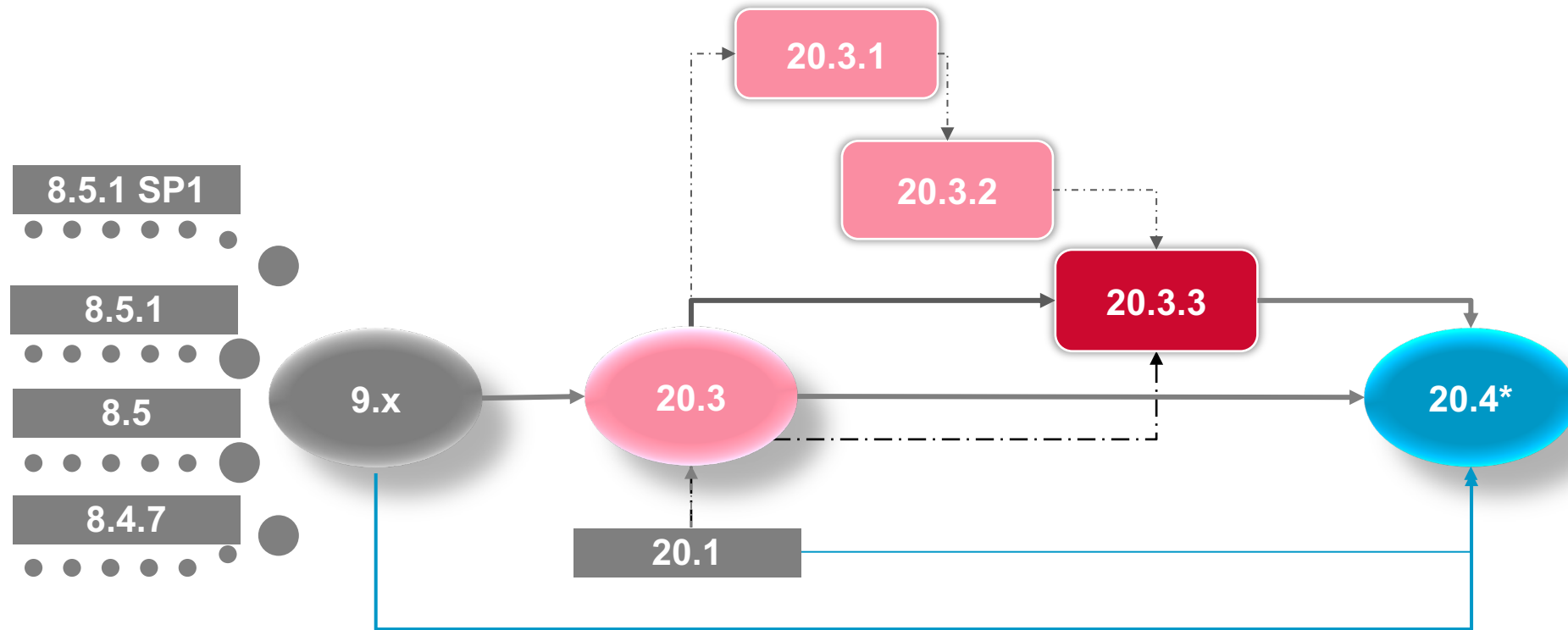
